Hopefully, the sheriff/deputies will come to the January meeting so discussions can take place.

Regarding streets signs on US 27, a conversation between Dr. Hendricks and INDOT has determined that 2 free standing signs have been installed.

Two citizens have agreed to serve; Doug Brenneke will join the Plan Commission, Joe Kaiser nominated, motion unanimous. Annemarie Chasteen has been nominated by Ben Lukacek, for the Plan Commission, Unanimous. Manuals will be handed out to the new members soon. The Plan is now filled with 7 members. The BZA and Plan Commission will meet in January and elect a chairman.

The Town has received a letter of Notification of Audit. The State Board of Accounts will be conducting and audit of the financial records for the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015. The field examiner is Annette Doerflien will be holding the audit in the Annex Building.

Rinehart's contract has been signed for snow and ice removal for 2016-2017 winter. The rate will be \$69/hour and \$34/bag of salt.

The fire contract has still not been signed. President Hendricks is still waiting to hear from the controller's office.
