

## MINUTES FOR THE TOWN OF SPRING GROVE

December 13, 2016  
HELD AT QUAKER HILL  
6:05 P.M.

Board members present included Adolph Werner, Ben Lukacek, Murlin Clark, and Ernest Hendricks. Also in attendance were A.J. Sickmann, Joseph Kaiser, Carol Polver, Rhonda Ozbun, and Annie Chasteen.

President Hendricks called the meeting to order and called for a motion on the minutes of the November meeting. Mr. Clark moved, seconded by Mr. Lukacek, to approve the minutes as corrected. Unanimous.

The Richmond Postmaster contacted A.J. Sickmann regarding the new gate. He will not deliver mail past the gate. More information to follow.

Sheriff Cappa reported that law enforcement has not been made aware of the gate.

Regarding the inter-local patrol, the results for the month have been posted. Dr. Hendricks will call Randy Wright to make sure that more speeding violations are given. Waterfall Road will be a zero tolerance zone. Citizens are not pleased that traffic has not slowed down. Hopefully, the sheriff/deputies will come to the January meeting so discussions can take place.

Regarding streets signs on US 27, a conversation between Dr. Hendricks and INDOT has determined that 2 free standing signs have been installed.

Two citizens have agreed to serve; Doug Brenneke will join the Plan Commission, Joe Kaiser nominated, motion unanimous. Annemarie Chasteen has been nominated by Ben Lukacek, for the Plan Commission, Unanimous. Manuals will be handed out to the new members soon. The Plan is now filled with 7 members. The BZA and Plan Commission will meet in January and elect a chairman.

The Town has received a letter of Notification of Audit. The State Board of Accounts will be conducting and audit of the financial records for the years 2011, 2012, 2013, 2014 and 2015. The field examiner is Annette Doerflien will be holding the audit in the Annex Building.

Rinehart's contract has been signed for snow and ice removal for 2016-2017 winter. The rate will be \$69/hour and \$34/bag of salt.

The fire contract has still not been signed. President Hendricks is still waiting to hear from the controller's office.

Mr. Lukacek then moved, seconded by Mr. Clark, adjournment at 6:40. Unanimous.
