June 13, 2017 HELD AT QUAKER HILL 7:00 P.M.

Deanna Call and Dr. Hendricks attended the exit conference for the State Board of Accounts audit. Most of the issues with the financial records had to do with checks/payments being received timely for permits. The final report will be sent after June 17, 2017.

Dr. Hendricks read a letter that he and Mr. Sickmann composed from the board to Craig Kinyon of Reid Hospital. The letter addressed the fire contract and property taxes. The board members signed the letter and it will be mailed as soon as possible.

Joe Kaiser retired. A chairperson is needed for the BZA.

A time for a workshop needs to be scheduled for ordinance changes before the next board meeting.
